Bookmark Embroidery

Embroider your own bookmark featuring Manitoba symbols. We want to see what you make! Show us by tagging us on social media.

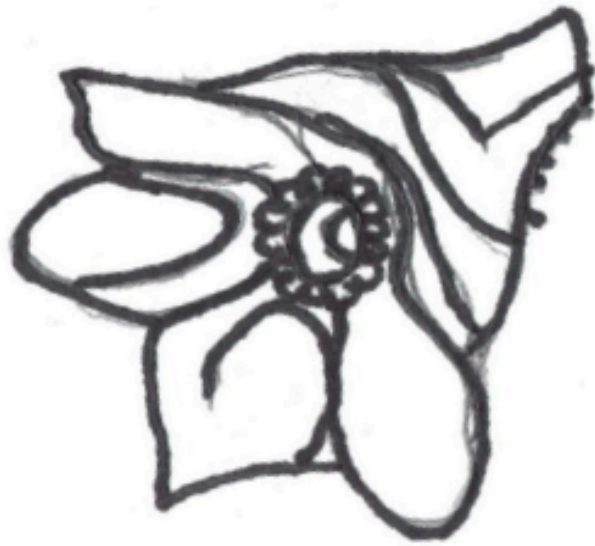
Supplies:

- Bookmark templates (printed on cardstock)
- Scissors
- Embroidery floss or yarn
- Needle

Instructions:

1. Pick a bookmark and colour of thread you want to work with.
2. Poke holes along the outline about 0.5 inches apart. This will make embroidering easier.
3. Following the pre-made holes around the outline of the image, embroider the bookmark.
4. When finished stitching or if you want to switch to a different colour, finish off and tie off the thread and start a new one.
5. Add embellishments with beads or buttons.

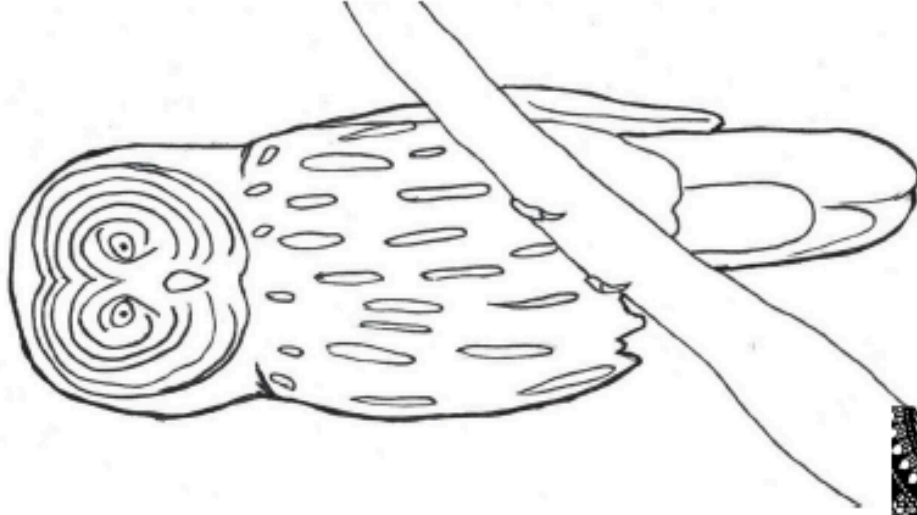

flower.



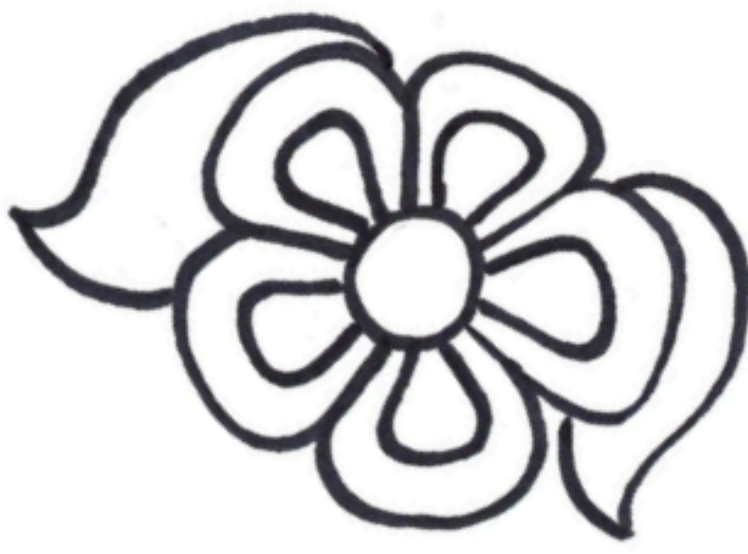
