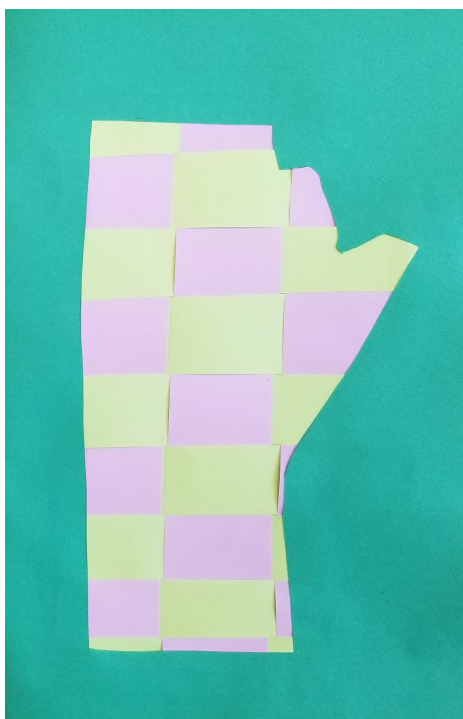




MCML's Spring Break Crafts at Home!



Paper Weaving Card

Make a Manitoba themed card embellished with paper weaving! Send it to your family, friends, teacher, or whoever. We want to see what you make! Show us by tagging us on social media.

Supplies:

- Card template
- Construction paper
- Coloured paper strips for weaving
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions:

1. To make the card: Using the template provided, cut out the shape of Manitoba. Then fold the card in half. Set aside.
2. To make the weaving: Pick 2 colours of paper you want to weave with. Take one sheet of paper and cut rows into it. Remember to not cut all the way, leave 1 inch at the top of the paper. Repeat along the length of the paper.
3. Take the other sheet of paper and cut strips, about 1 inch thick.
4. Start weaving the paper strips through the sheet with the cut rows going over and under the rows. Repeat until you have reached the bottom of the paper. Note: each row will be the opposite of the previous row. If the first row was woven over first then under, the second row will be woven under first then over.
5. When finished weaving secure the edges of the weaving and glue over the cutout of the card. Trim any excess if needed
